ADMISSION PROCEDURE IN 50% ACPC, GoG SEATS of M.PHARM (2020-21):

The candidate needs to apply to the ACPC for centralised admission process to get admission in these seats.

The candidates are advised to refer the website of Centralised State Admission Committee (ACPC): www.jacpcldce.ac.in and www.gujacpc.nic.in for the further details such as Seats available, Eligibility of admission, Reservation and Distribution of seats, Merit List preparation, registration and admission procedure of admission on ACPC seats. The following information is provided herewith as mentioned in the ACPC website.

Eligibility of Admission for M.Pharm.:

1. Passed B.Pharm with 55% (50% for SC/ST/SEBC/EWSs candidates) **AND**
2. Obtained valid qualifying marks in GPAT OR Appeared at Common Entrance Test (PGCET) with Merit Rank in the Merit list of the current academic year conducted by Admission Committee for professional Courses (ACPC).

The eligibility as above is subject to change and therefore candidates should verify it with notifications issued as and when of Centralised Admission Committee and should consider the same to be final and binding.

Preparation of Merit List:

The eligible candidates would be allotted admission by ACPC as per the merit lists of the candidates who have applied for admission within the prescribed time limit to ACPC and who are found eligible for admission under these rules, in the following manner, namely:

- 1) The first merit list shall be prepared on the basis of valid marks/score in GPAT.
- 2) The Second merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in PGCET of that corresponding year.

The criteria for deciding merit order in case of candidates having equal merit marks shall be in the following sequence, namely: (a) Percentage of marks obtained at qualifying examination; (b) Date of birth (candidate who is older in age shall be given priority)

If the seats remains “Vacant OR not reported” after completion of the admission process by the ACPC for ACPC-GoG seats (i.e., after the final round of allotment), then admissions of such vacant seats would be processed directly by the institute as MQ seats from the waitlisted candidates of MQ inter-se-merit list as per the norms of the ACPC.

The candidate may lose his/her right of admission against ACPC seat allotment, if he/she doesn't report to college within the stipulated date to complete the admission formalities at the college. The photocopies of all relevant documents alongwith ACPC allotment letter, token fee receipt and passport size photo has to be submitted at the time of reporting and will be verified with the original copies. The remaining fee is to be deposited through NEFT/ IMPS/ RTGS/ Cheque/ Demand Draft at the college to confirm his/her admission.

A candidate may withdraw or cancel his admission during the admission process or before date as notified by ACPC as per norms. However, it should be noted that refund of fee deposited shall only be applicable if such vacated seat is filled by waiting candidate and such admission made against vacated seat is duly approved by ACPC. Refund of fee in such cases shall be processed after deduction of processing fee as per norms after the admission process is completed and its approval by ACPC.

In case of queries if any, the candidates may contact college office during working days between 9.00 am to 3.00 pm
